One of the proven effective practices of our institution is the execution of house examinations in every organized way. In the beginning of the session the examination in charge of the college with guidance of the Principal decides the tentative schedule for the house examination and internal assessment. The college frames the schedule for the house tests of every semester beforehand. The college maintains the record of attendance and award lists of house examination. During the staff meetings, proper discussion on results of house tests are done. Requisite remedial and enrichment material is provided to the students for improving their performance in final examination.
